EXPLANATION

1. The medium of instruction and examination is in English.
2. The performance of the student in all the courses shall be evaluated on a ten-point scale with the corresponding grade values as follows:

70-74	A++	Very Good	8

Below 50	F	Fail	0

A Candidate to be successful has to obtain a minimum of 50% marks or the grade equivalent to that i.e. 'B' in every course. Those who secure 'F' grade shall be declared as fail.

3. The grade secured at the Repeat/Re-Repeat examination shall carry letter ® at the top. The delay in submission of project or repeat in project is noted as '(RP)'
4. 'I' at the top indicates that the grade was obtained after Improvement Examination.
5. '*' at the top indicates graded but non-credit component of examination.
6. $SGPA = \frac{\sum \text{E.G.P Earned in a Semester}}{\sum \text{Total Credits in a Semester}}$; where E.G.P stands for Earned Grade Point (E.G.P= Credits of a Course×Grade Point).
7. $CGPA = \frac{\sum \text{E.G.P Earned in all Semesters}}{\sum \text{Total Credits in all Semesters}}$.
8. Percentage given on consolidated Mark Statement is an actual mark percentage.
