The MAHARASHTRA NATIONAL LAW UNIVERSITY AURANGABAD, a National Law University established by passing a separate Statute by the State Legislature of Maharashtra namely, Maharashtra National Law University Act, 2014. Realising the importance of quality legal education and the need of well-trained law graduates at the Bar, Bench and professions, State Legislature of Maharashtra took the decision of creating three independent and autonomous National Law Universities in the State of Maharashtra at Mumbai, Nagpur and Aurangabad. The latest being the Maharashtra National Law University, Aurangabad, which commenced from March 16, 2017.
